coffee, and a catered lunch.


Clear your calendar and get yourself there, and the rest will be taken care of. We hope this will be a relaxing and rejuvenating day of connection.


1. Worship; 2. Learning and teaching; 3. Individual and congregational lifestyle; and 4. Community, national, and global advocacy/involvement.










Lake Junaluska to hold three women retreats in 2023
