Shake It Off and Step Up

Dear Friends from the Living Waters District, Happy Advent, Merry Christmas and Blessed Epiphany! During this high and holy season of the church, I'd like to ask you to ponder which of the two Gospel "Christmas" stories is your favorite? Is it Matthew's story that is told mostly through Joseph's perspective or is it Luke's story that follows Mary's experience? Regardless of our answer, one thing is certain, they both found themselves in an impossible, unexplainable and unpredictable state of chaos as God was about to do something totally unexpected in these two persons' lives that would change the relationship between God and humanity forever.

Perhaps you have heard the parable of a farmer who owned an old mule. One day, the mule fell into the farmer's well. The farmer heard the mule braying and went to the site. After assessing the situation as hopeless, the farmer sympathized with the mule but decided that neither the mule nor the well was worth the trouble of saving. Instead he called his neighbors and asked them to bring their shovels to help him bury the poor mule and put him out of his misery. The mule seemed hysterical and when the dirt struck his back, he shook it off. And as the farmer and his friends continued to shovel dirt onto the mule, a thought struck the farmer. After each shovel of dirt was thrown onto the mule he said, "Shake it off and step up." The mule did what he asked and after a time, the old mule stepped triumphantly out of the well! What seemed to bury him actually became his road to freedom. There is an alternative to every impossible situation!

As we prepare once again for this high holy season, I would like to invite us to consider Mary's

question posed to the angel Gabriel in Luke 1:34a, "How can this be?..." (Wouldn't we all like to have a dollar for every time we have asked that question in our lifetime?)

When we bring this profound question to God it opens the door to recognize God's abiding presence, grace, mercy and justice that enters into our circumstances, problems and chaos. At times, the way forward is not always visible to us. But maybe the way "upward" – like that poor mule in the story experienced, is the better way forward.

In both the Matthew and Luke stories of Jesus' birth, that same question, "How can this be?" became a wonderful pathway of learning about, and leaning on Emmanuel (God with us). It still is today. So where ever we find ourselves this Holy Season, my prayer for us all is to be open to discover that God is with us....always!.



SAFER SANCTUARIES TRAINING

We are proud and excited to announce that the Living Waters District now has 4 Conference Trained Safer Sanctuaries Trainers. In an effort to improve awareness among our congregations, we would like to offer several different trainings, throughout the District.
